STIPULATED ORDER REGARDING FACTS PERTAINING TO MOVIE من PREVIEWS/TRAILERS AND WAIVER OF AUTHENTICITY OBJECTION TO SPECIFICALLY IDENTIFIED EVIDENCE

The State and the Defense, in a mutual effort to reduce the scope and quantity of certain testimony otherwise necessary at any future pre-trial immunity ("Stand Your Ground") hearing and/or any trial, stipulate and agree to certain facts; both parties also waive any potential "authenticity-" objection to the specifically identified evidence listed below;

The State and the Defense stipulate to the following facts:

- the specific movie previews/trailers played on January 13, 2014 in the theater wherein the shooting occurred are correctly listed in the "Dolby Sever Log C2-C2, Trailer Pack List of Trailers Played on January 13, 2014 and Other Information;" ("Dolby Sever Log C2-C2");
- (ii) the specific sequence of the movie previews/trailers played in the theater wherein the January 13, 2014 shooting occurred is correctly listed in the Dolby Sever Log C2-C2;
- (iii) both parties have not been able to precisely determine which specific movie preview/trailer was playing at the exact time of the shooting incident.
- (iv) the times of the events listed under the "Log from Projector," which is contained within the Dolby Sever Log C2-C2, are not accurate. Accordingly, no stipulation is made

regarding the accuracy of the listed times and the listed corresponding events in the Log from Projector portion of the Dolby Sever Log C2-C2; and

(v) the lighting setting of the movie theater was set at "mid-one" at the time the movie previews/trailers played on January 13, 2014 in the theater wherein the shooting occurred.

The State and the Defense further agree that "authenticity" under this Stipulated Order means that the below referenced item of evidence is what this Stipulated Order describes it to be, thereby removing any need to authenticate and/or identify it pursuant to section 90.901, Fla. Stat.; and

The State and the Defense agree that both parties reserve their right to raise relevancy and/or any other legal challenge(s) to the admissibility of each and every specifically identified item of evidence within this Stipulated Order.

The State and the Defense further agree that this Stipulation Order will remain in full force and effect for all hearings and trials of this case.
