 Florida, in the said County, under oath, Information makes that

CURTIS JUDSON REEVES

in the County of Pasco and State of Florida, on the 13th day of
 January, in the year of our Lord, two thousand fourteen,
 unlawfully, by an act imminently dangerous to another, and
 evincing a depraved mind regardless of human life, but without a
 premeditated design to effect the death of any particular
 individual, did kill Chad Oulson, by shooting Chad Oulson with a
 firearm, and during the commission of the offense, CURTIS JUDSON
 REEVES actually possessed and discharged a firearm and, as the
 result of the discharge, death or great bodily harm was inflicted
 upon Chad Oulson; contrary to Chapter 782.04(2)/775.087(1)/
 775.087(2)(a)3, Florida Statutes, and against the peace and
 dignity of the State of Florida. [L4]/10

COUNT TWO

And the State Attorney aforesaid, under oath as aforesaid, further
 information makes that CURTIS JUDSON REEVES, in the County of
 Pasco, State of Florida, on the 13th day of January, in the year
 of our Lord, two thousand fourteen, did actually and intentionally
 touch or strike [REDACTED] by shooting [REDACTED] with a
 deadly weapon, to-wit: firearm, against the will of [REDACTED]
 and during the commission of the offense, CURTIS JUDSON REEVES
 actually possessed and discharged a firearm and, as the result of
 the discharge, great bodily harm or permanent disability or
 permanent disfigurement was inflicted upon any person; contrary to
 Chapter 784.045(1)(a)2/775.087(2)(a)2/ 775.087(2)(a)3, Florida
 Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of
 Florida. [B2]/7
