On 02.12.2014 at approximately 12:30 pm, Investigator Neil Fraley dropped off a DVD disc for me to examine to determine if, or what might have been thrown at the time of a shooting in Theater 10. The DVD contained a processed timeline video from several cameras. The video was not what I needed to fully examine the incident, so I requested the "original" videos from Cobb Theatre.

On 02.18.2014 at approximately 11:10 am, Investigator Fraley brought a sealed paper bag that contained a locked black "Husky" case. The case contained (9) Internal Hard Drives. There were inside individual Evidence Bags and labeled. (The sequence of order was made by me).

- 1) 2nd Drive DVR 4 (13017451) - Cams 2, 3, 8, 9, 11 & 12
- 2) Original Drive DVR 4 (13017454) - Empty
- 3) Original Drive DVR 1 (13017457) - Empty
- 4) 2nd Drive DVR 2 (13017456) - Only video from 01.14.14 & 01.15.2014
- 5) Secondary Drive DVR 1 (13017459) - Empty
- 6) Original Drive DVR 5 (13017455) - Empty
- 7) Original Drive DVR 3 (13017452) - Cams 1, 5, 13 & 16
- 8) Secondary Drive DVR 3 (13017461) - Empty
- 9) Original Drive DVR 2 (13017453) - Cams 2, 3, 5, 8, 9, 14

The case also contained seven "thumb" drives. I examined them, but for this report they were not used. I showed Investigator Fraley what I had observed in the initial timeline video of Camera 12, Theater 10. The reflections observed appeared to follow the person as he exited the row, and appeared to be at or near his feet. The reflections did not appear to be from a stationary object. The reflection also appeared on Camera 12, Theater 10, before the incident. **(Photos of Husky Case)**

Both images show the reflection that I showed the Investigator.

I did not receive a Digital Video Recorder (DVR) to play the hard drives in. I requested one, but there wasn't one available. I had an FDLE "IT" employee make a test download of the first four files in the hard drive number one from my list. The video had the file extension "GMP4". This file requires the "codec" GeoVision player v8570 Pack to be installed. After installing it, I was able to view the files with universal players like Windows Media Player.

I examined all of the hard drives and found that the cameras for the theater were mixed over three hard drives, (1), (7), and (9). Some of the hard drives were blank, some only had the dates 0114 and 0115, and some would not boot up.

Videos are from different hard-drives, and the times do not show on the videos. Labels referenced for images are camera number, file number, and then elapsed times for each file.

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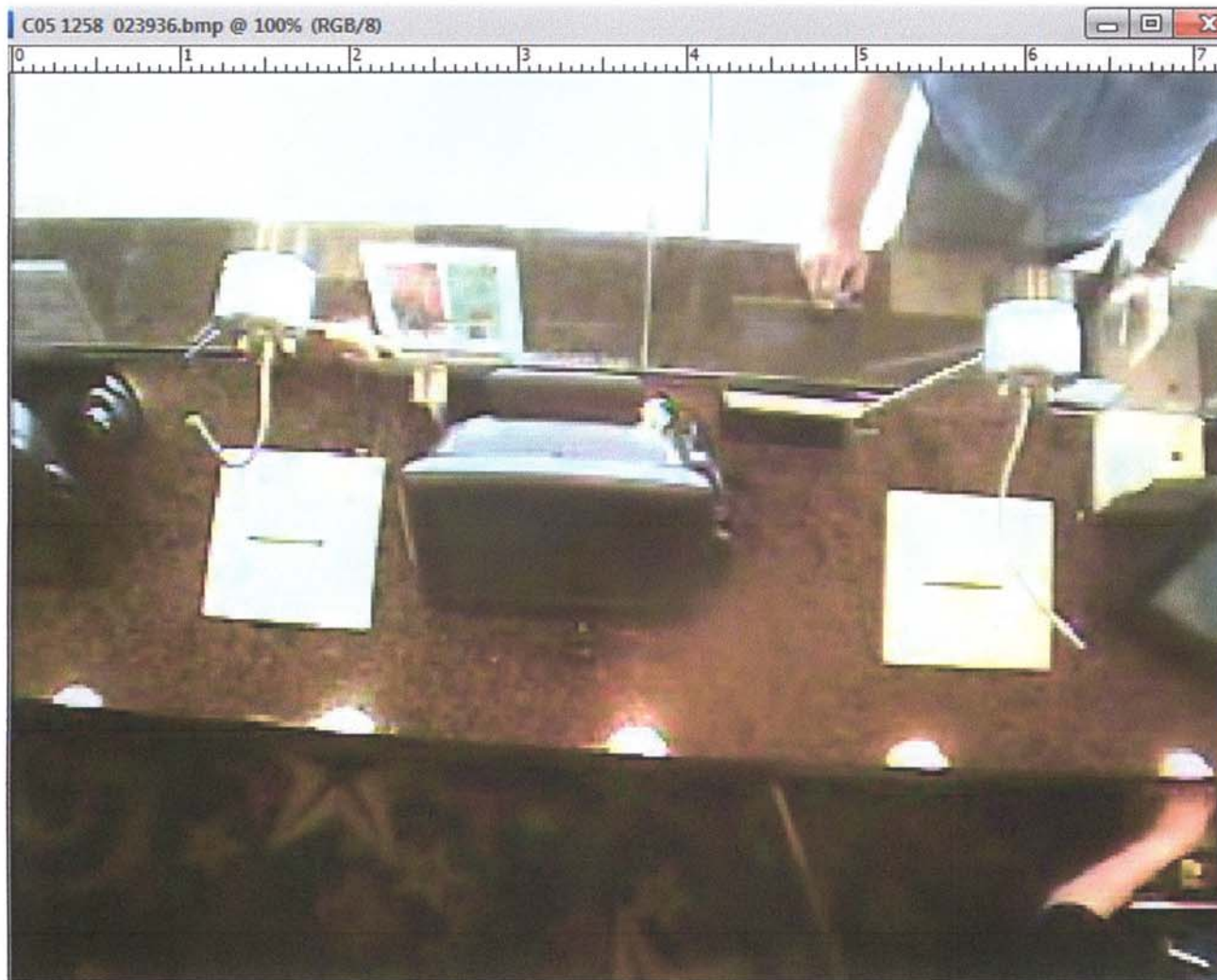

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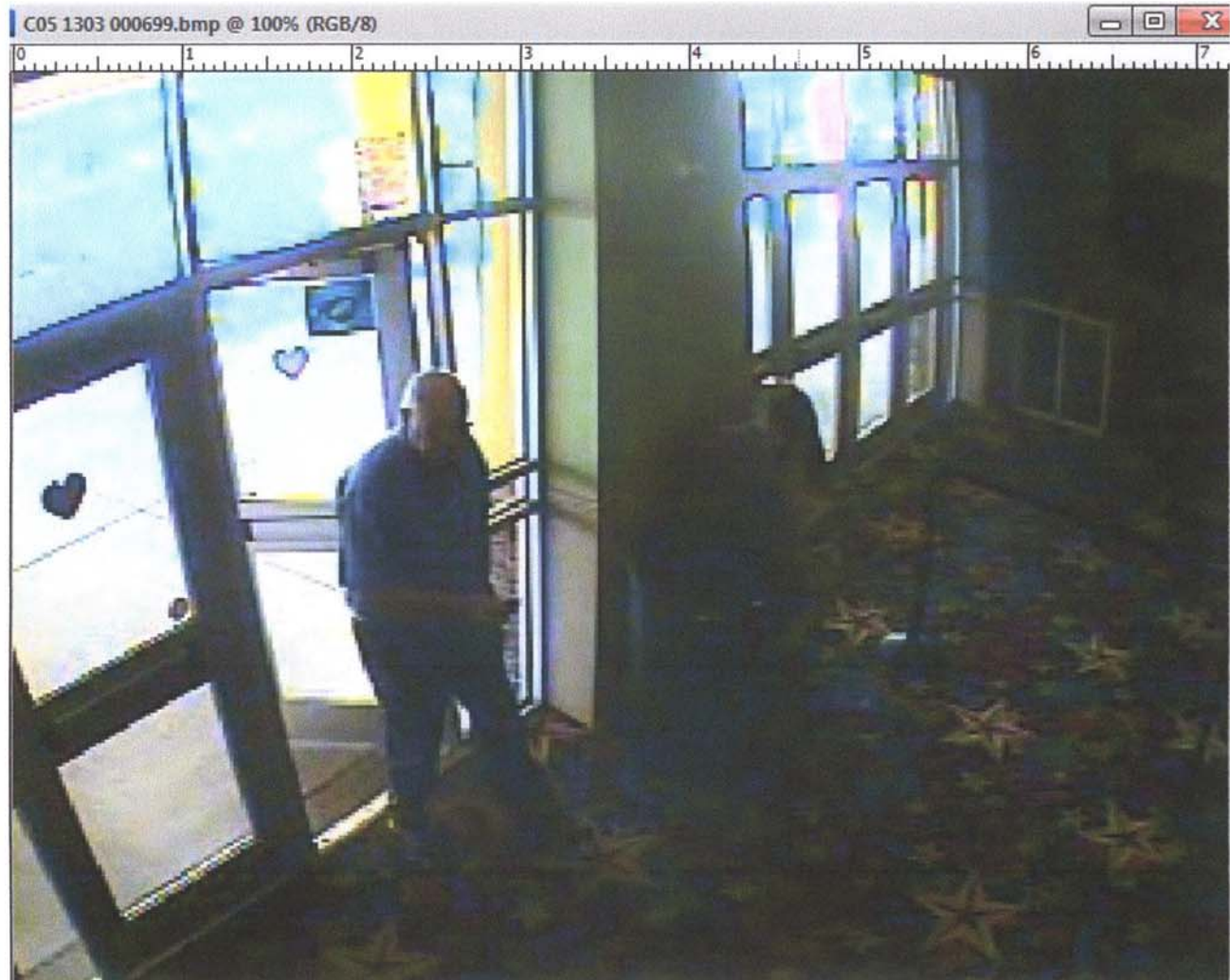

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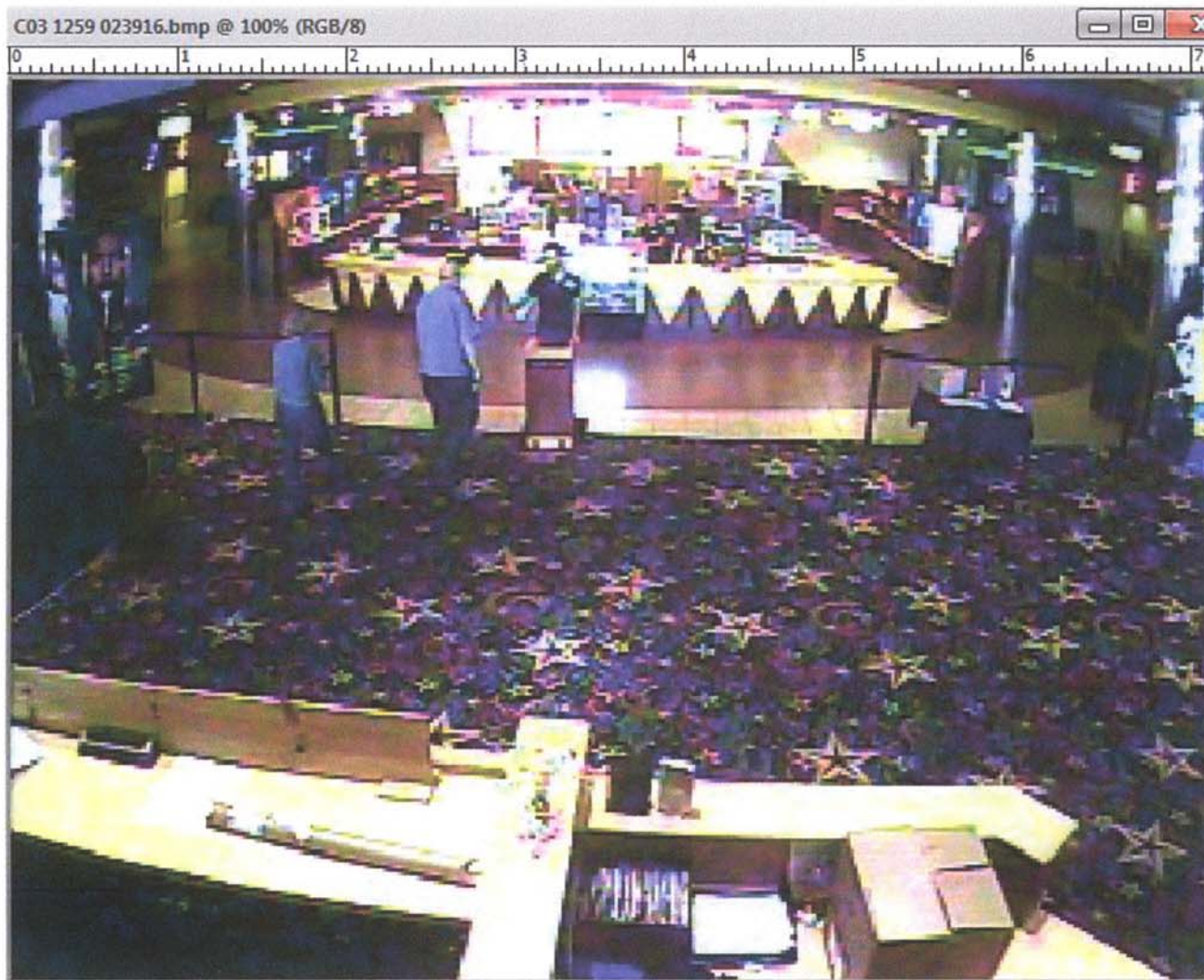

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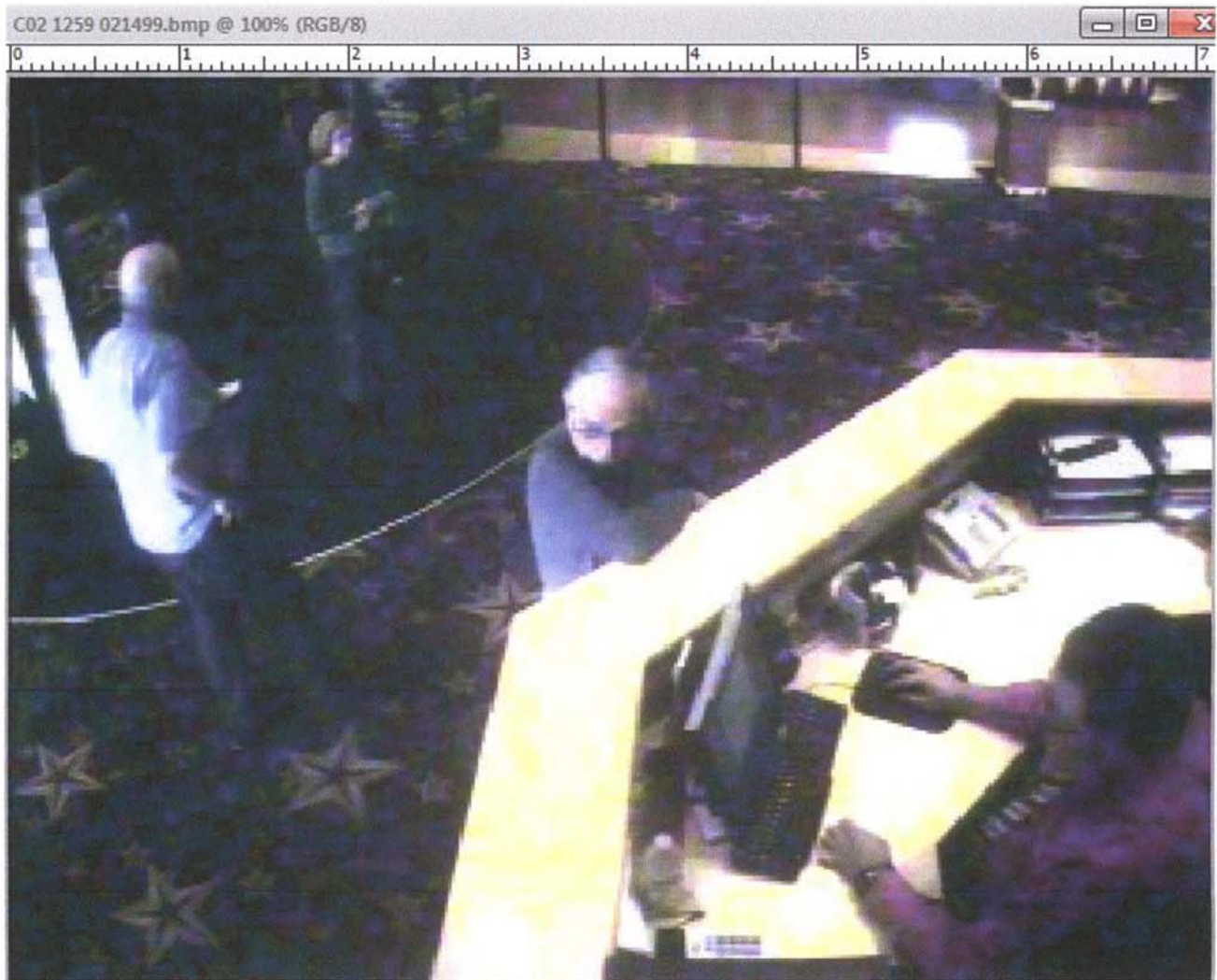

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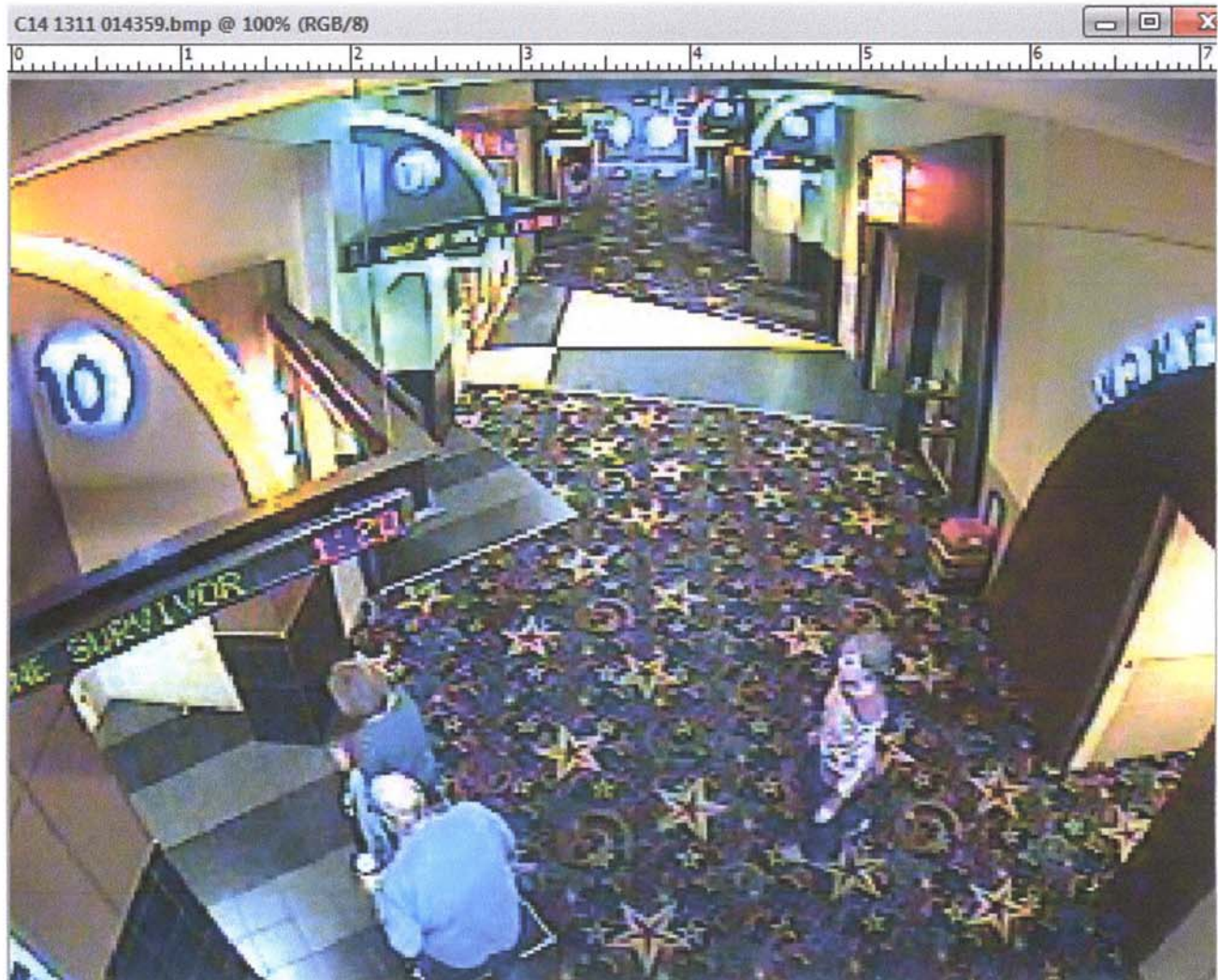

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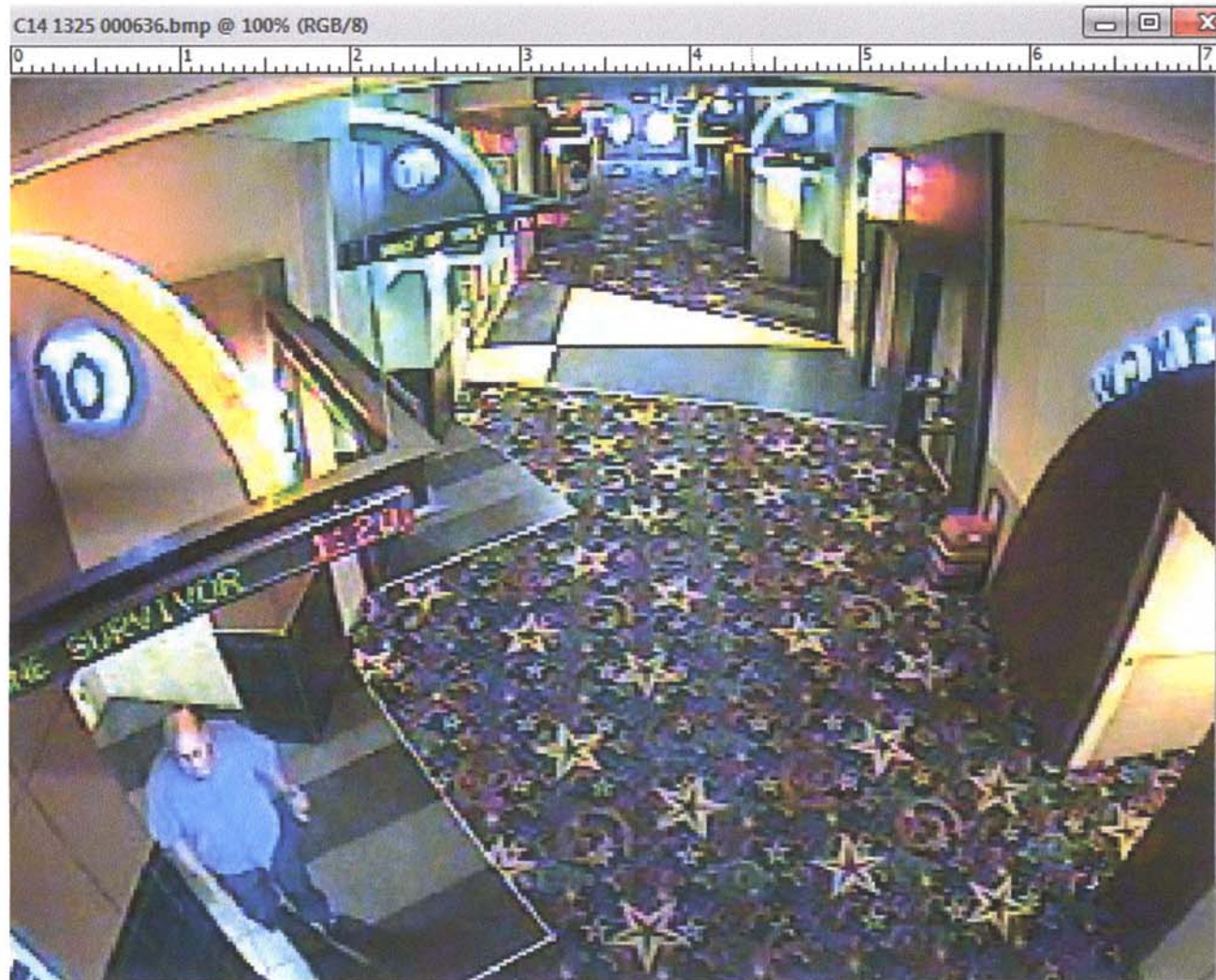

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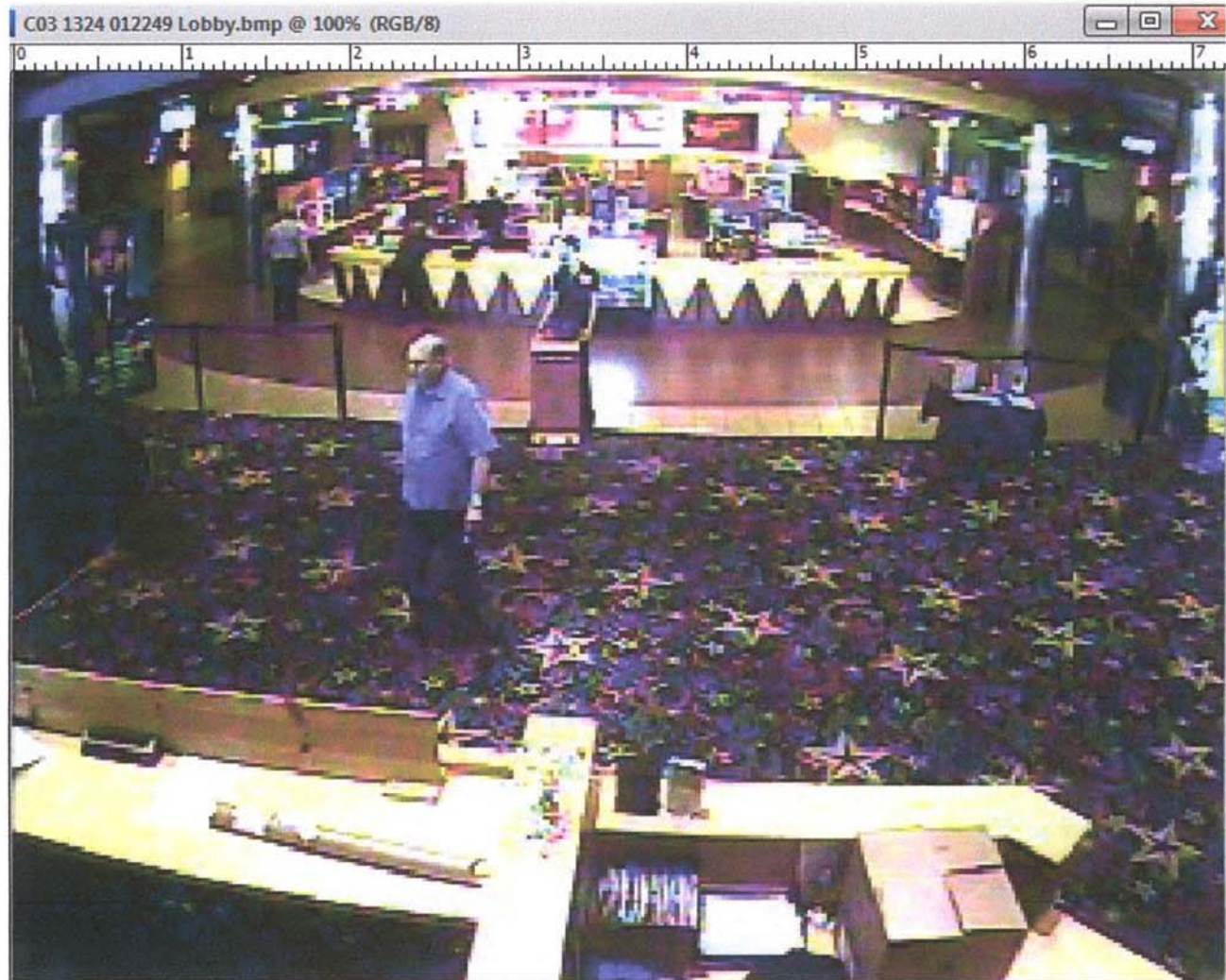

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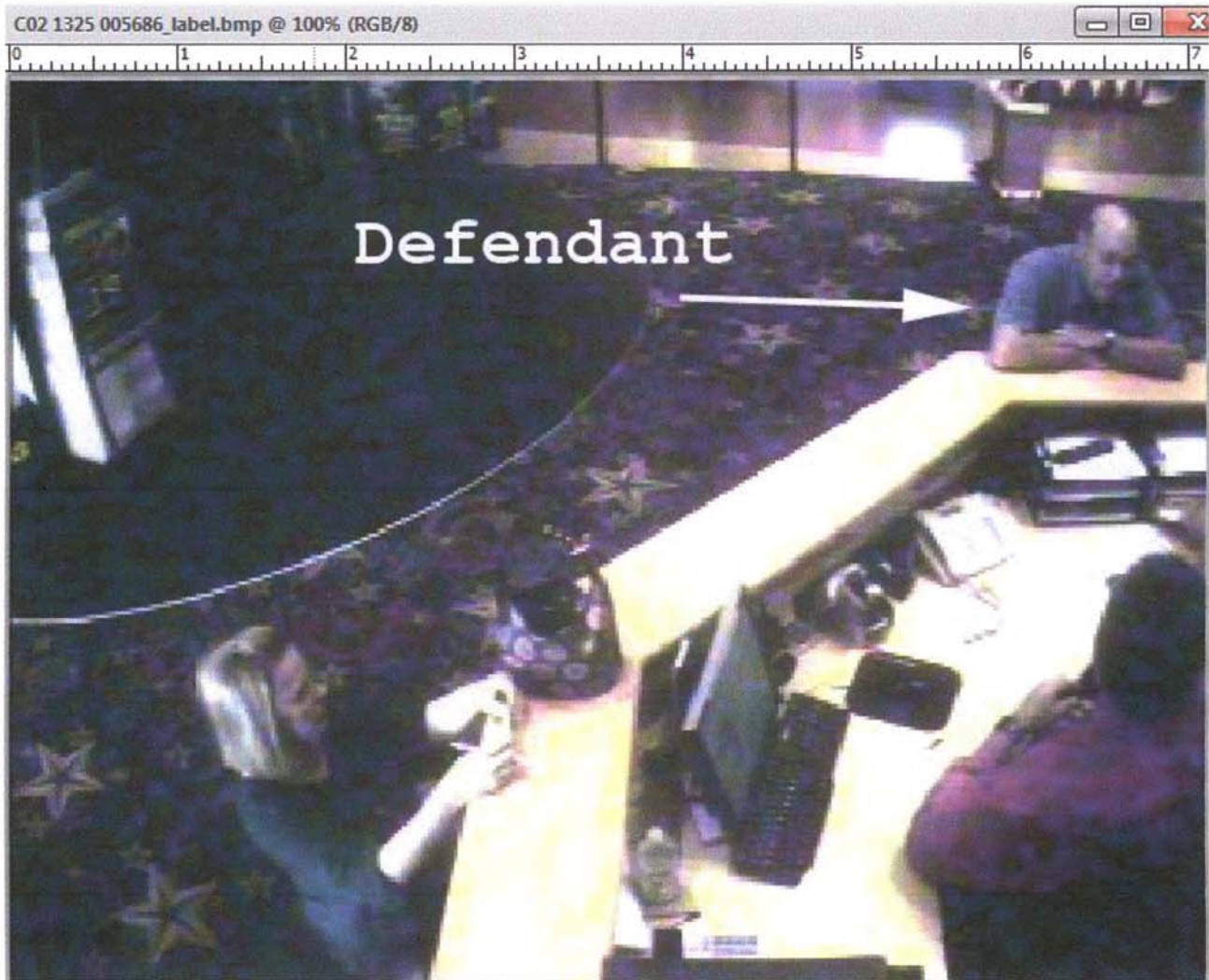

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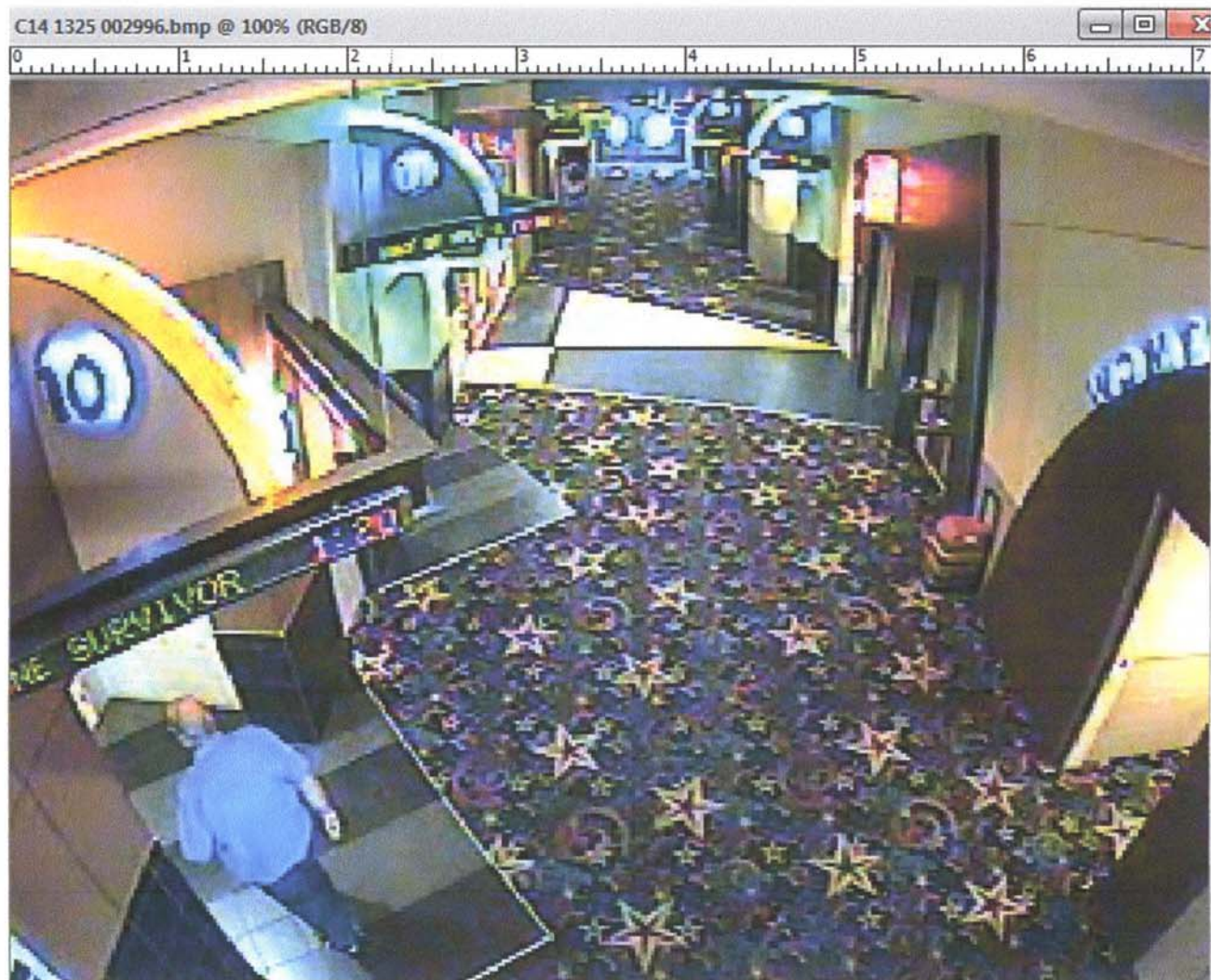

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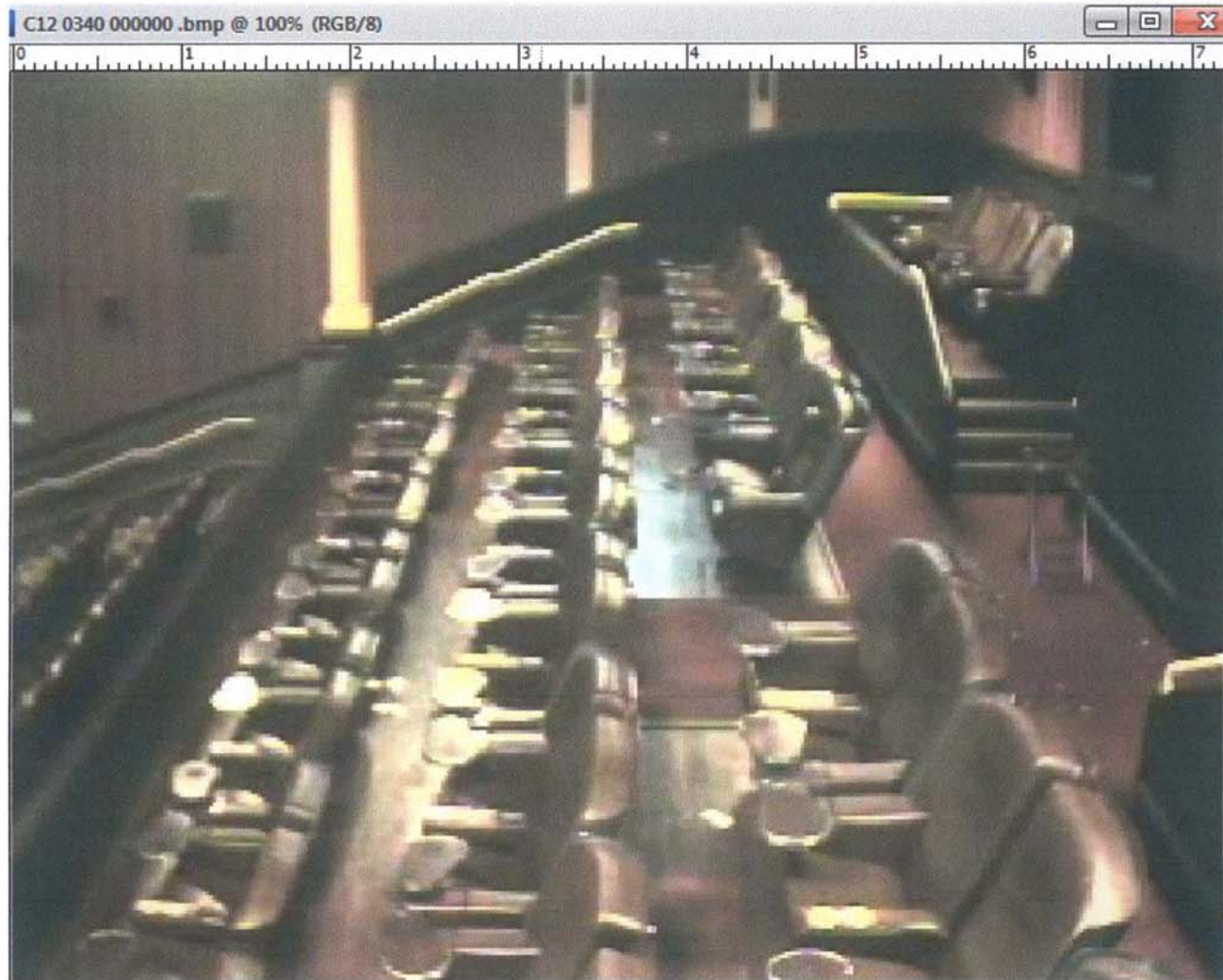

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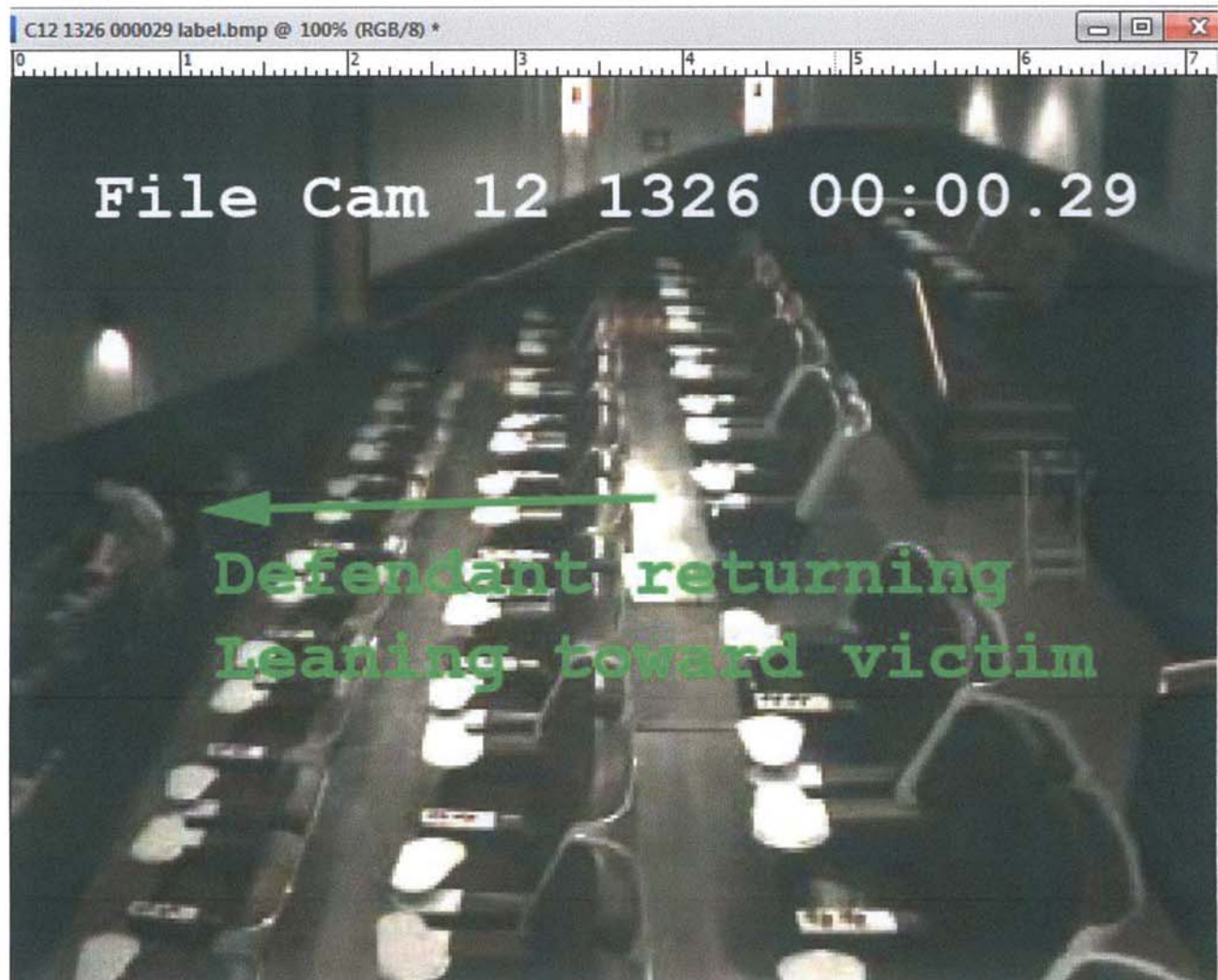

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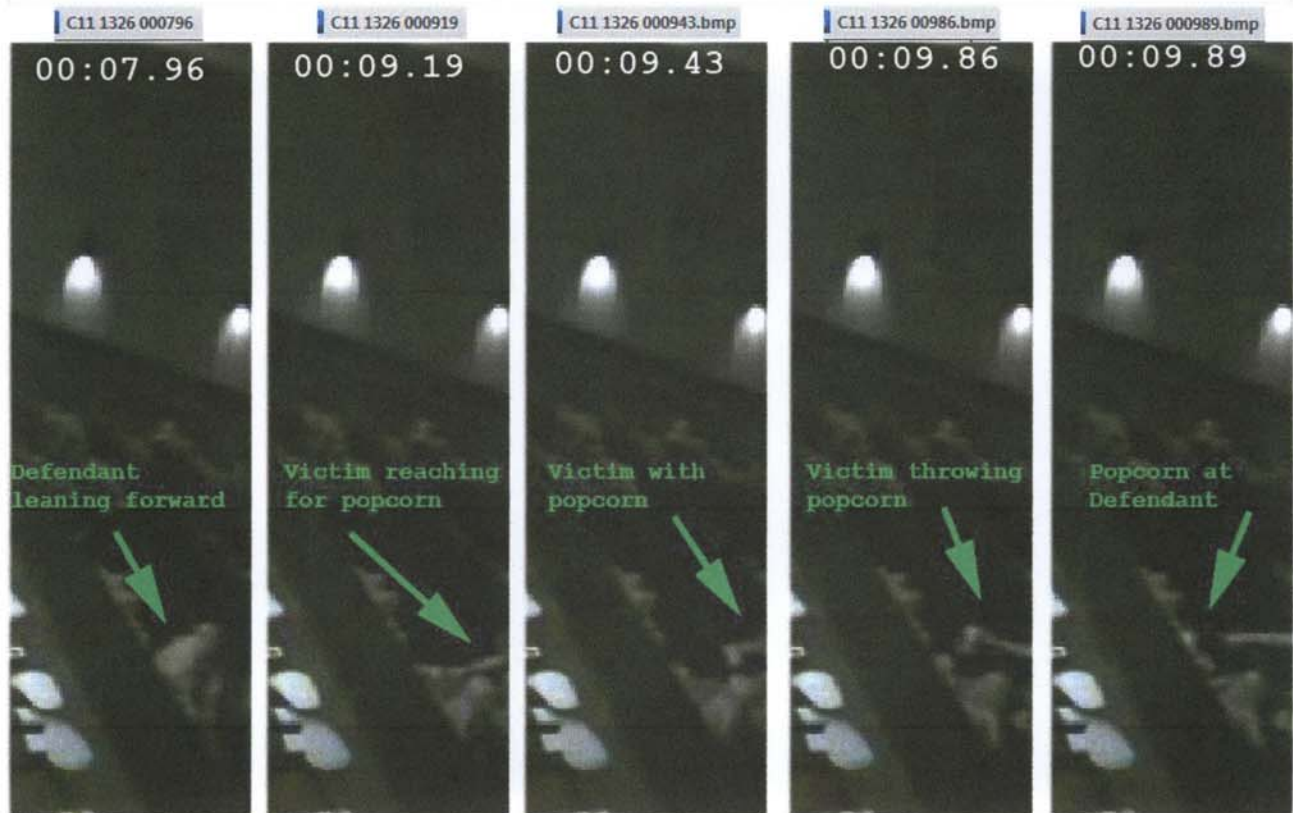

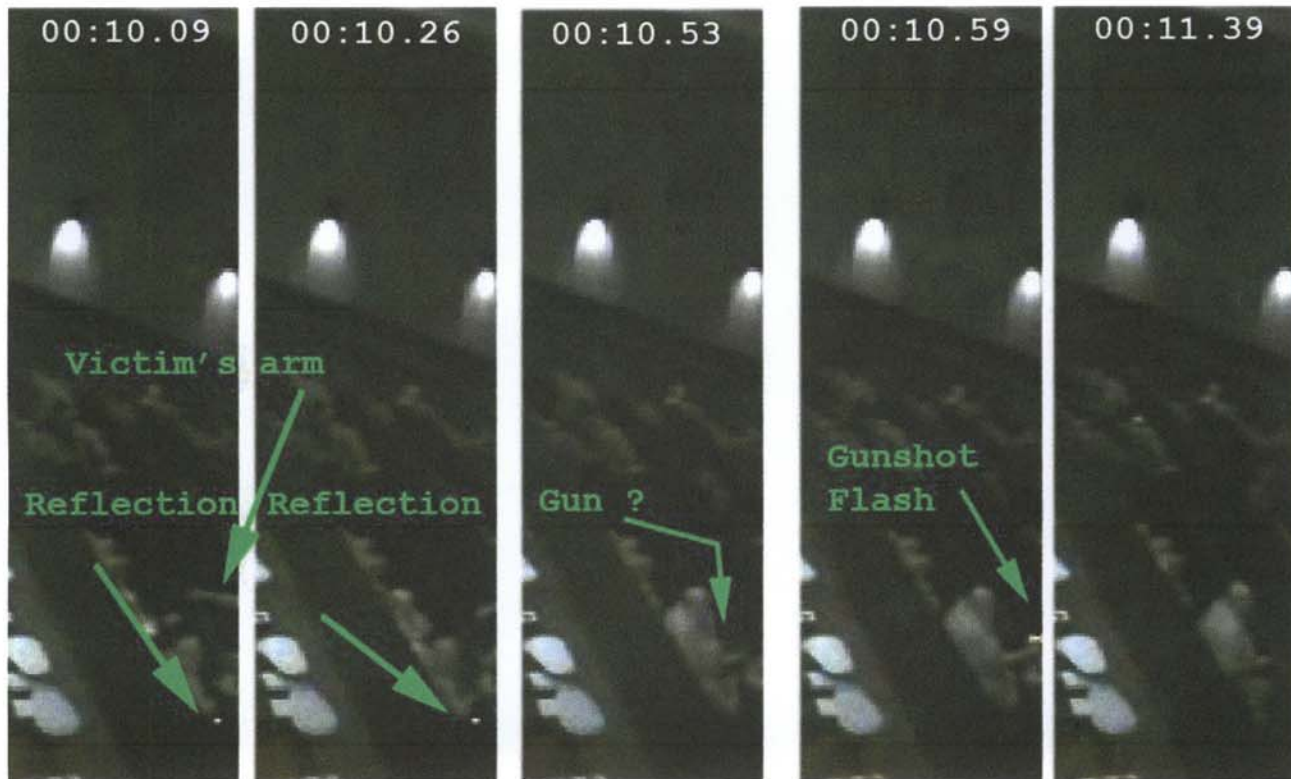

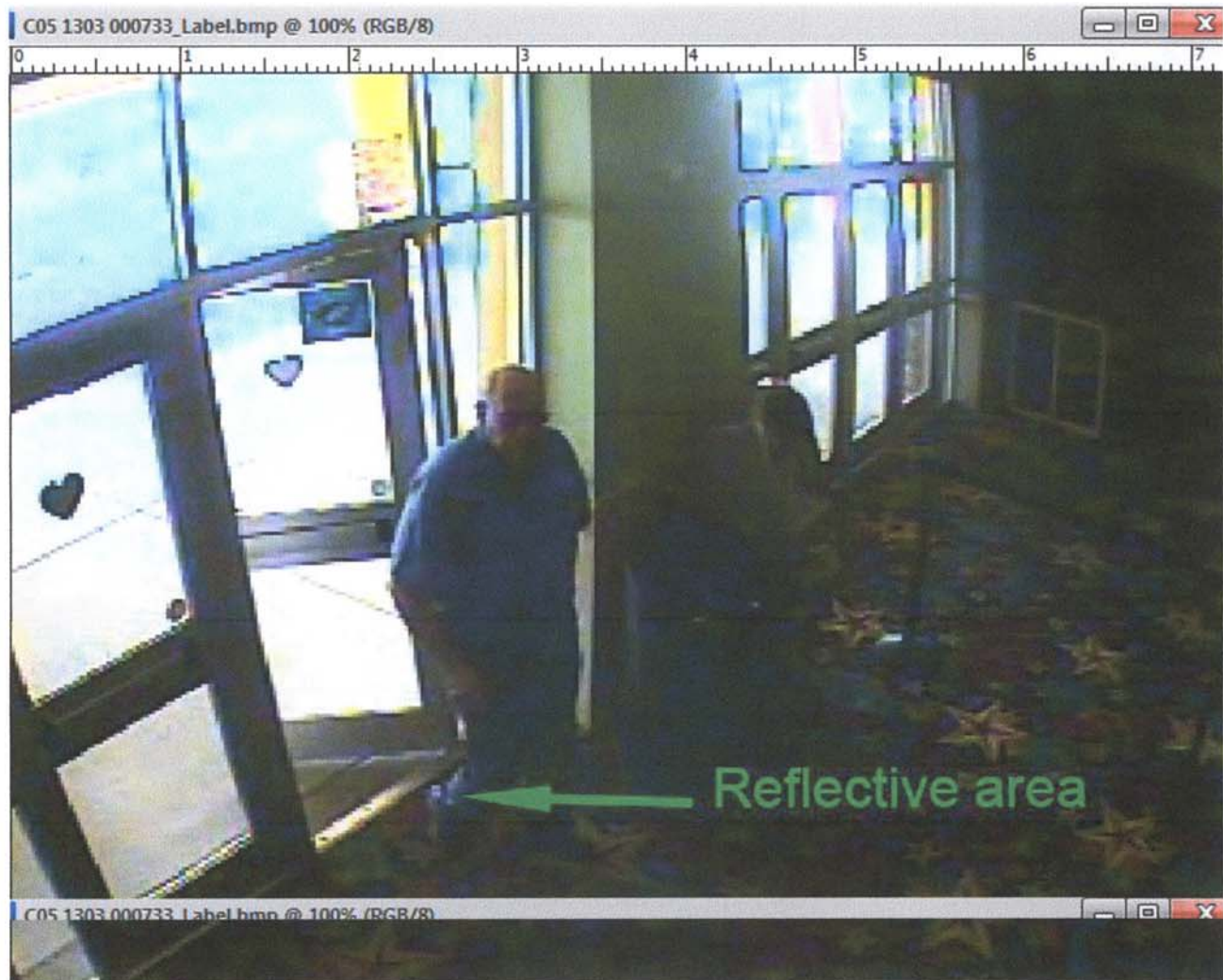

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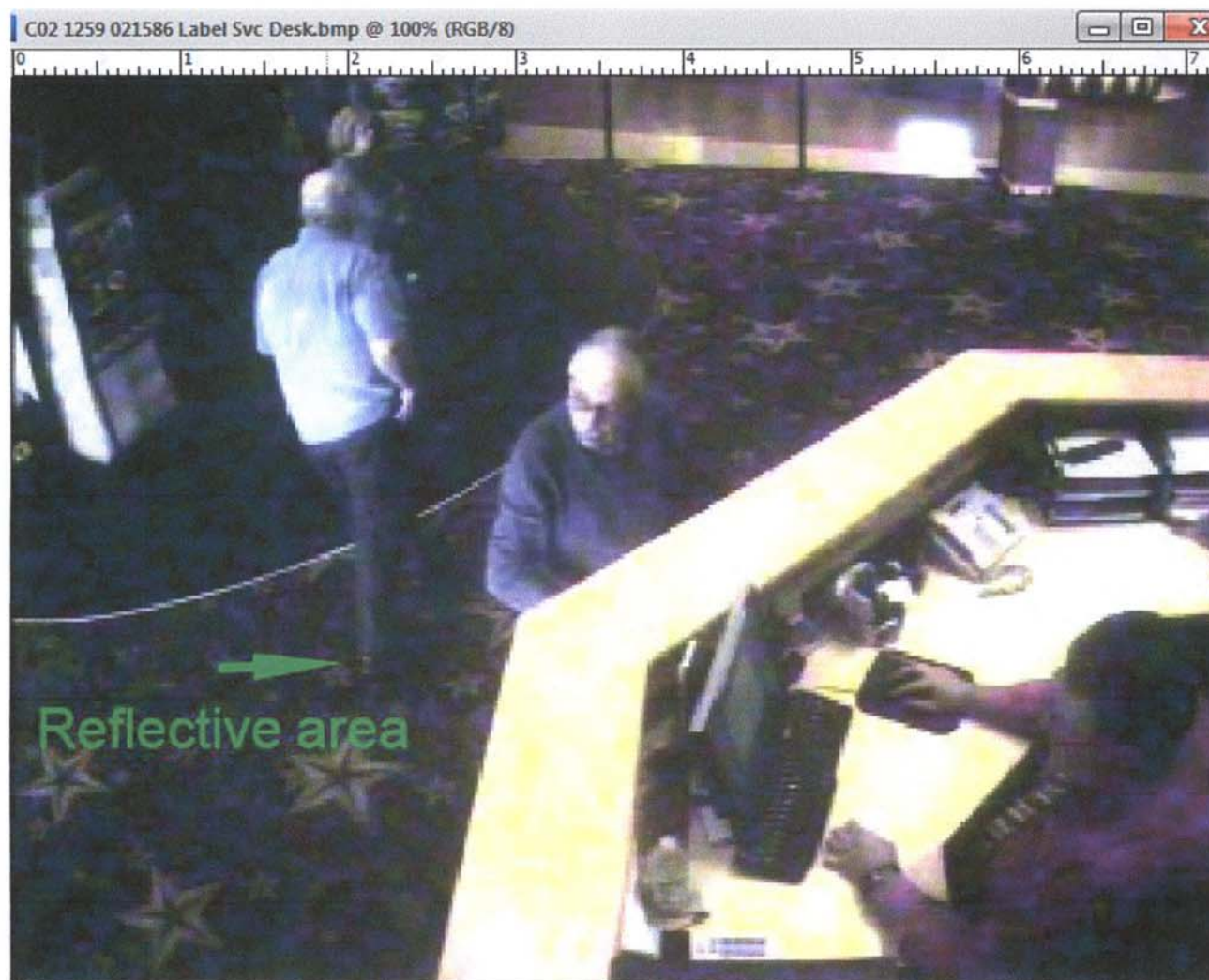

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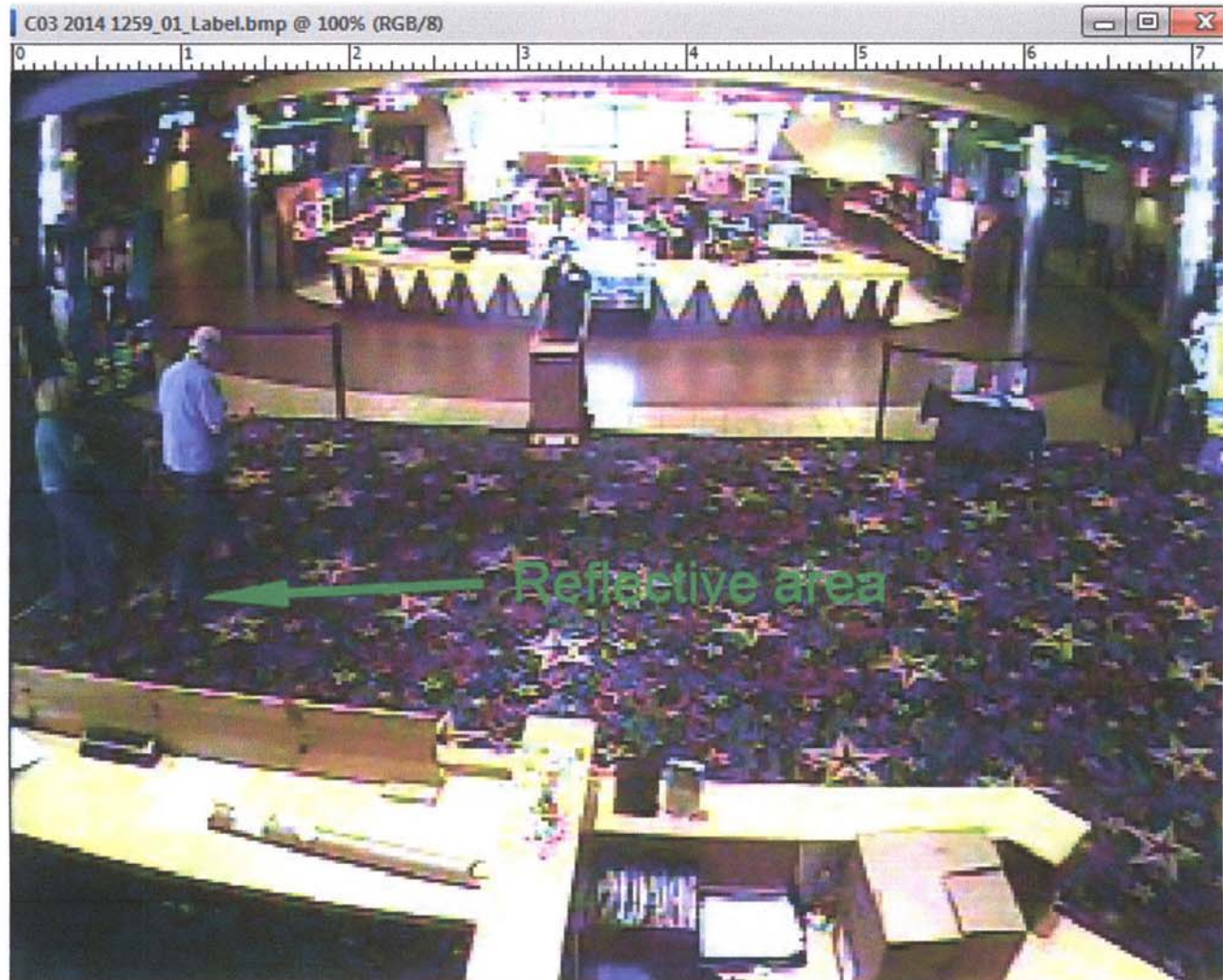

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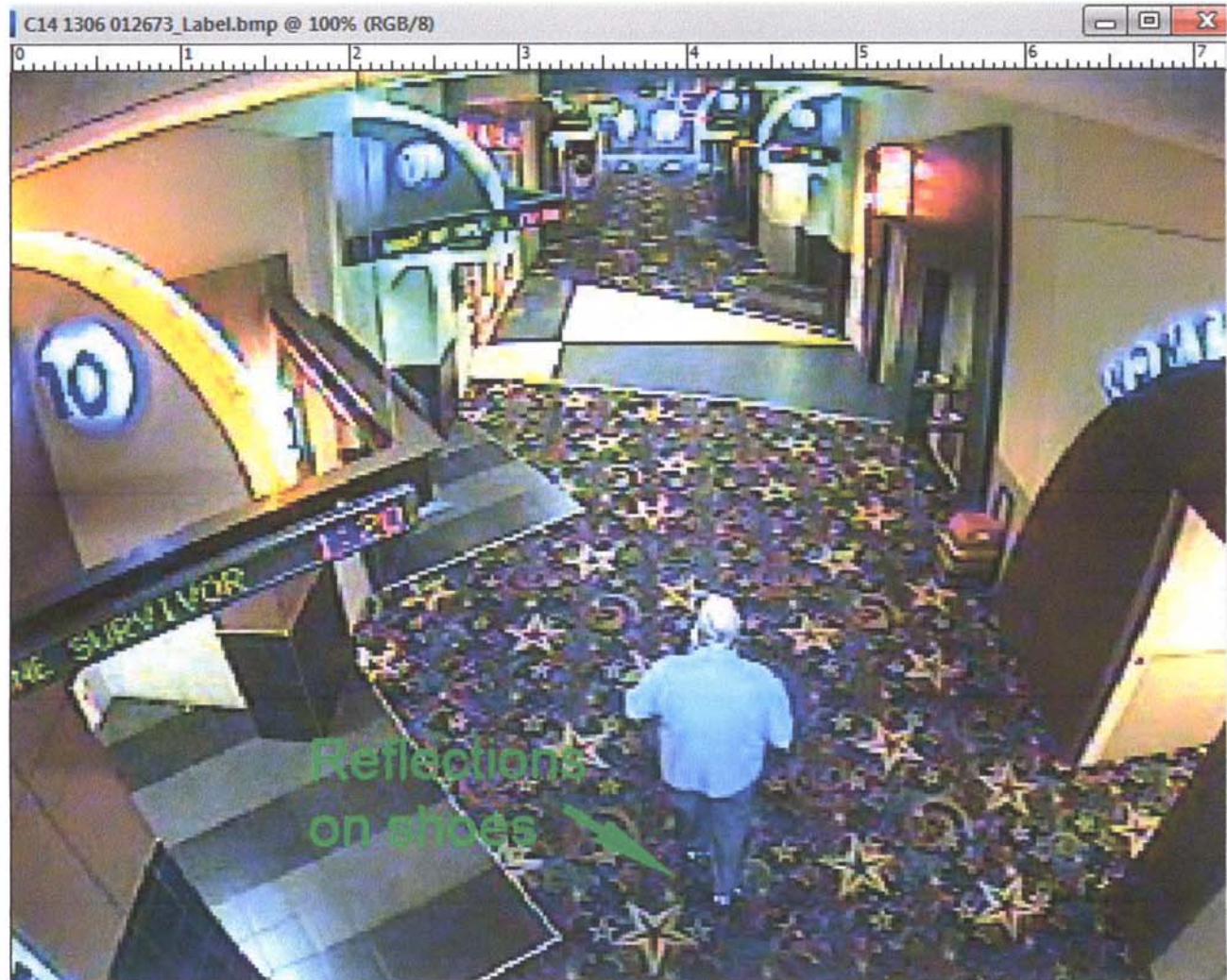

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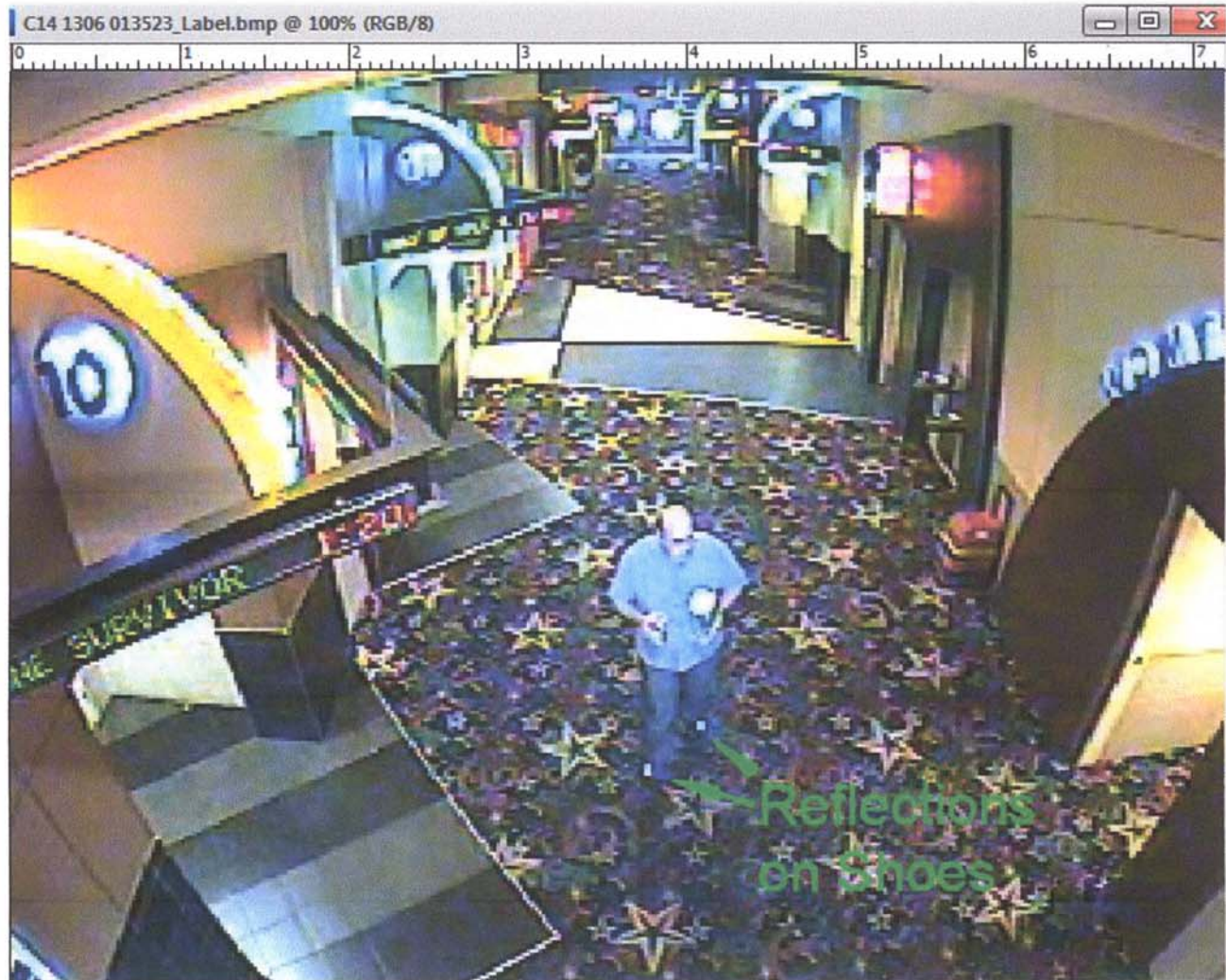

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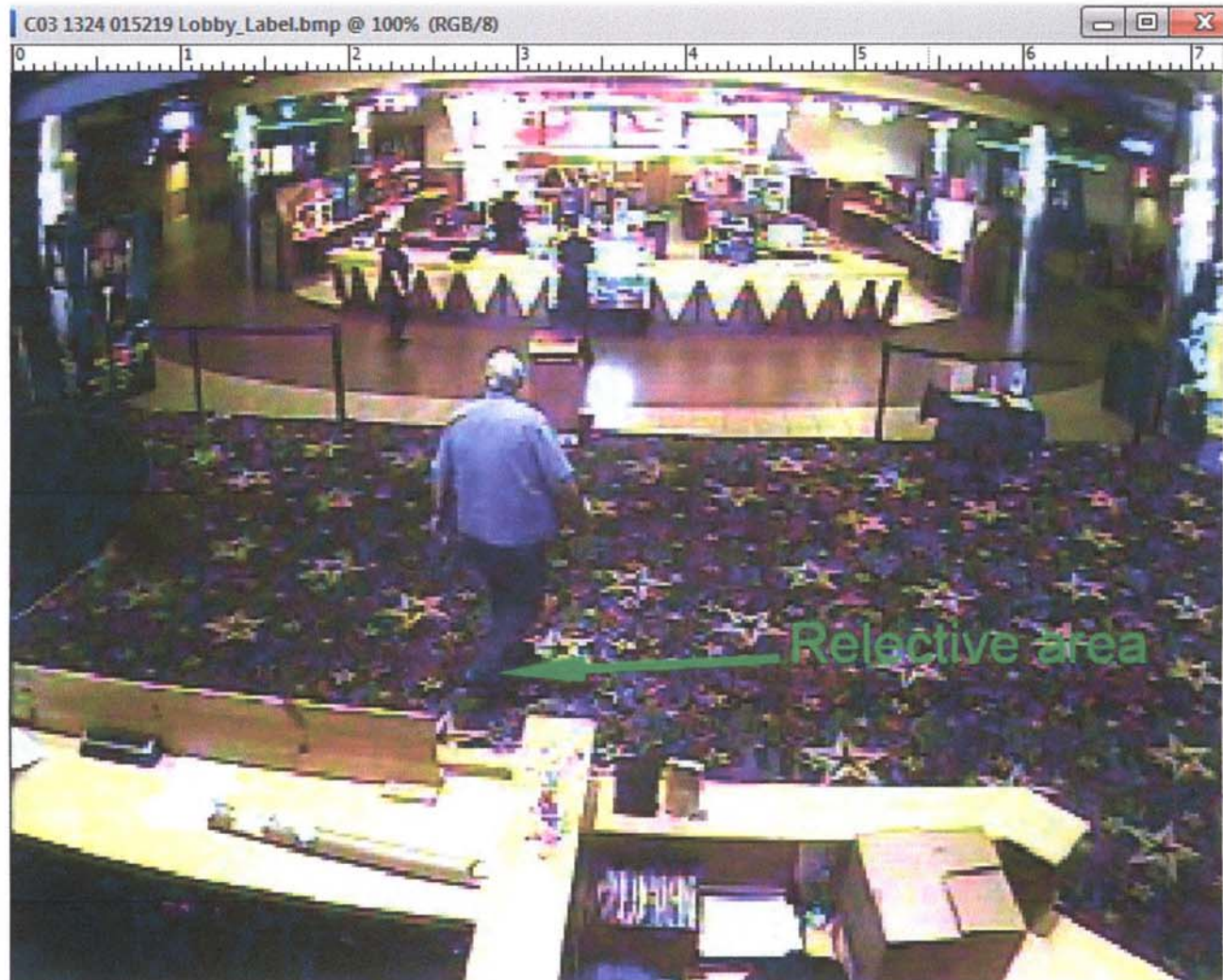

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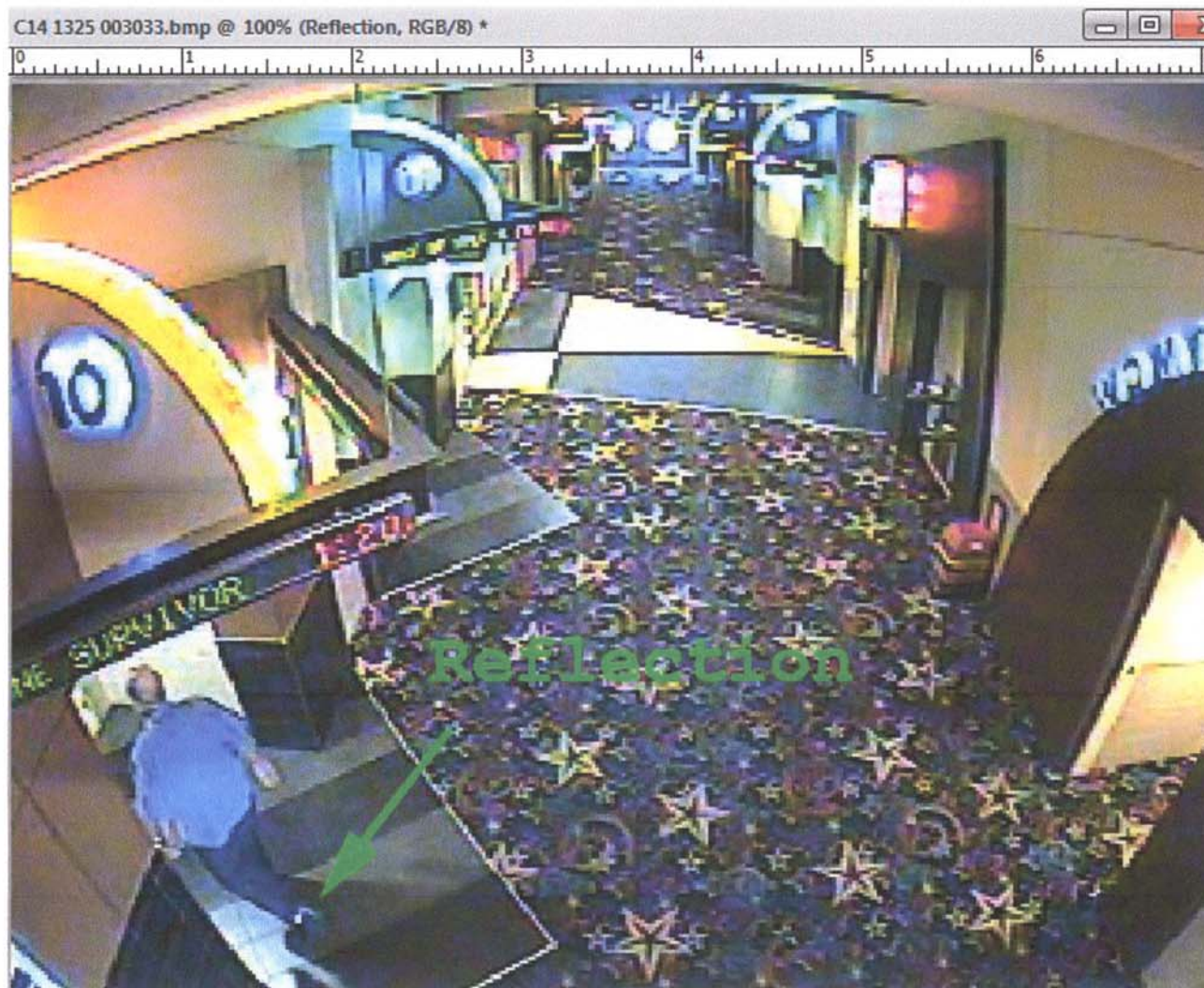

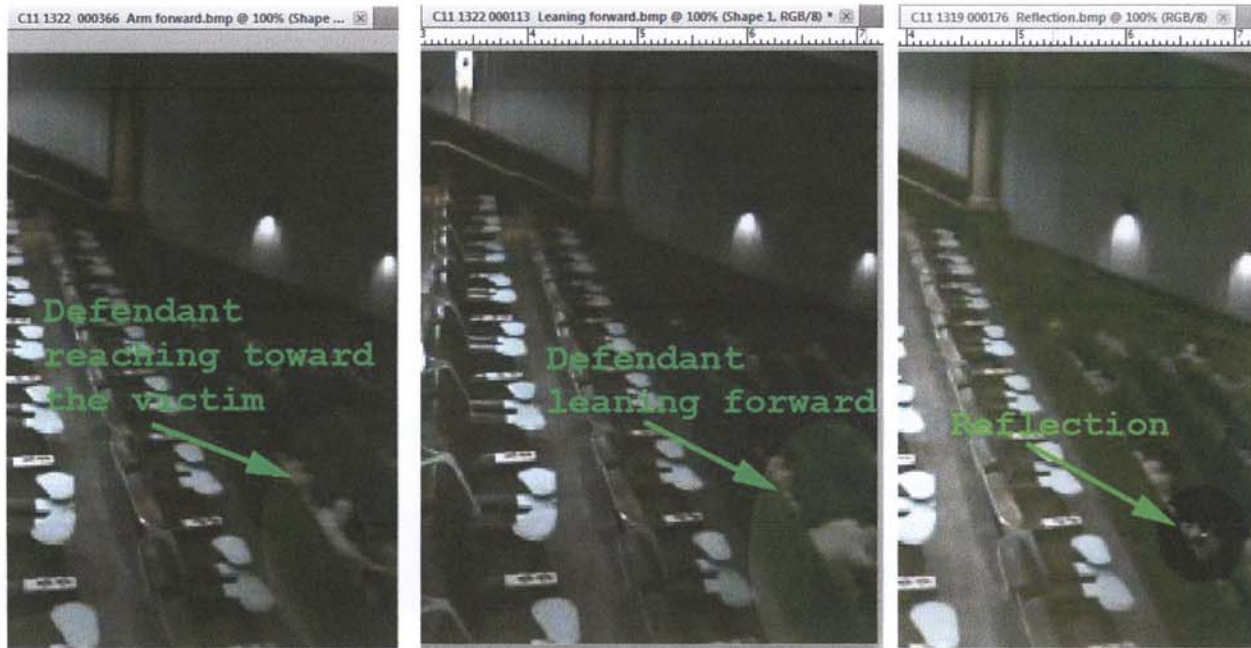

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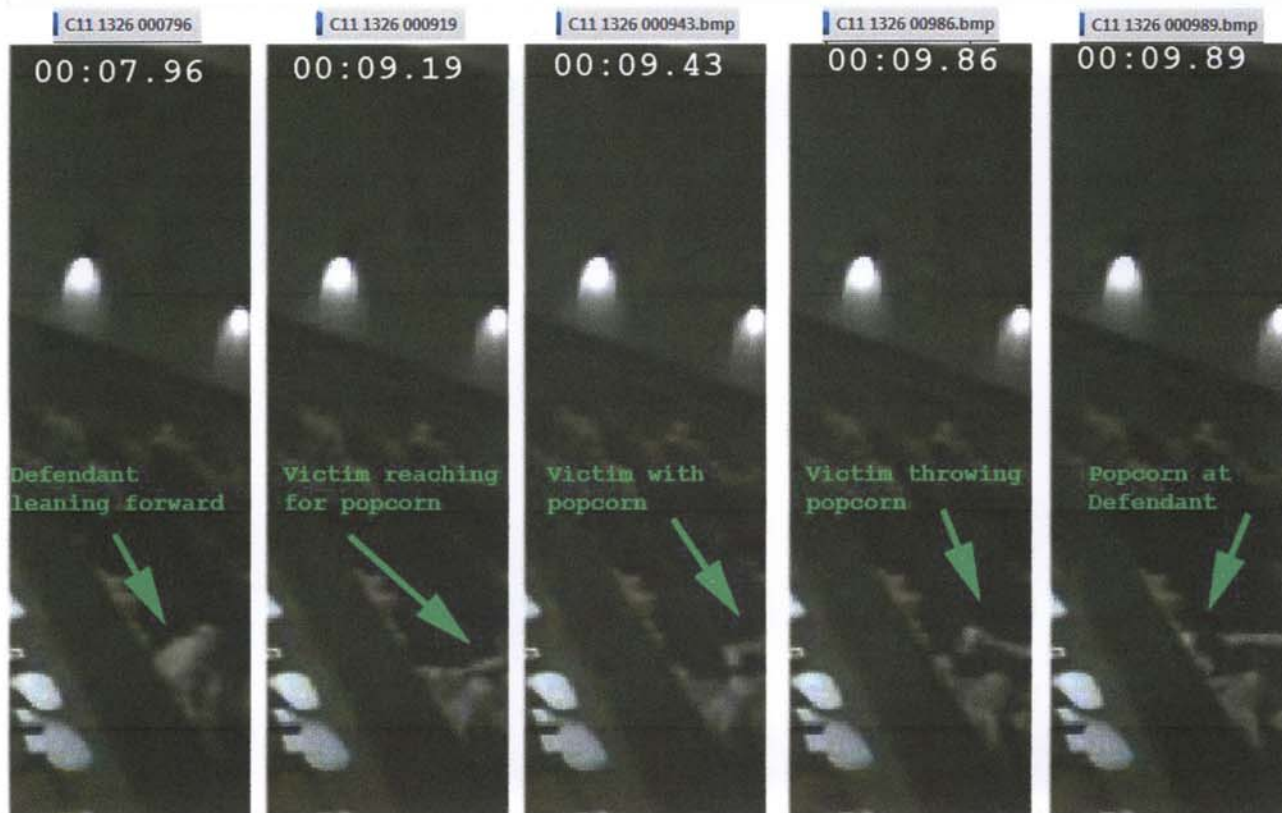

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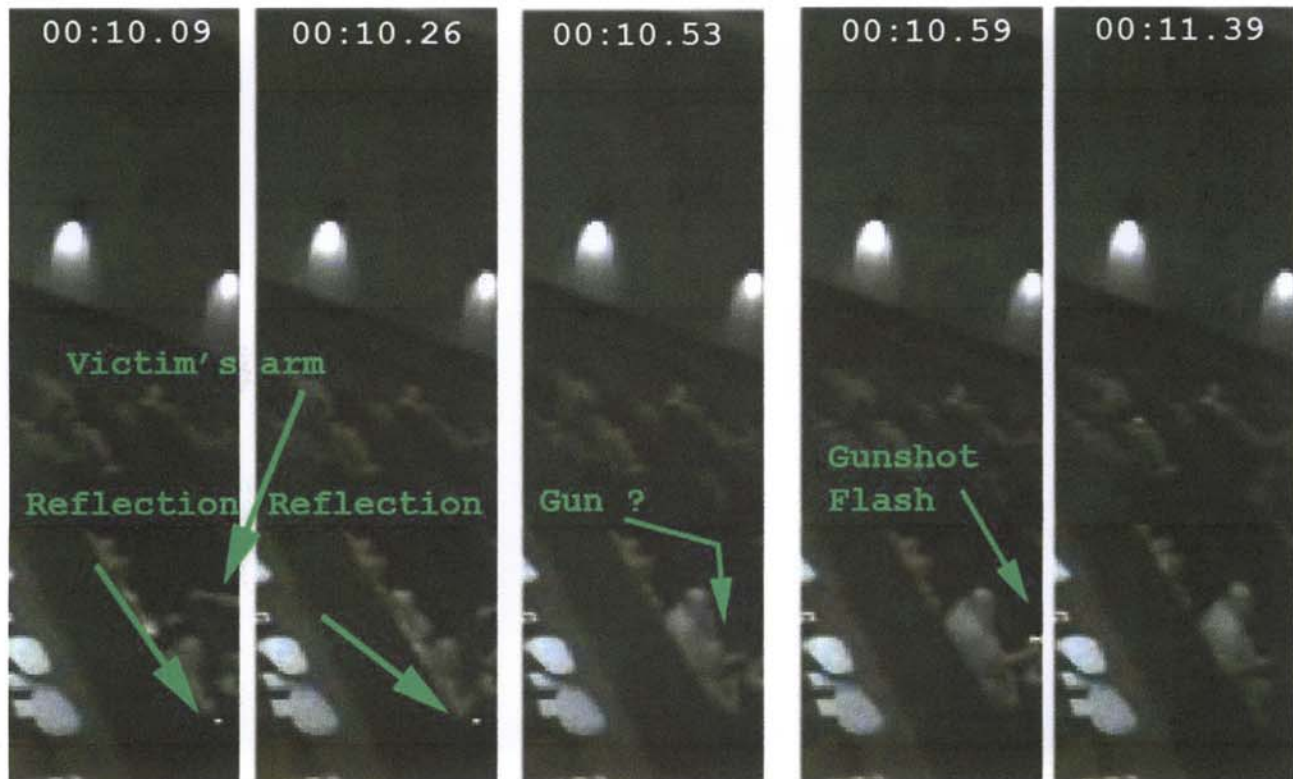

RESULTS:

Examination of the Exhibit #SJG-3 shirt revealed a hole in the upper front area. The area around this hole was visually and microscopically examined and chemically processed for the presence of close range firearm discharge residues. Residues in the form of partially burned and unburned gunpowder and bullet wipe were found. Using the Exhibit #AP-01 pistol, the Exhibit #AP-03 magazine, laboratory ammunition, and the Exhibit #AP-04 and Exhibit #AP-02 submitted ammunition, comparable residue patterns were found at distances less than thirty-six (36) inches muzzle-to-object.

Exhibits #SJG-1A, #SJG-1B, #SJG-12, #SJG-13, #SJG-14, and #SJG-1C were not examined.

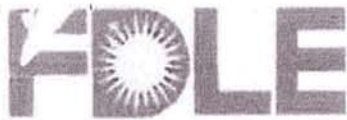

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


- Performed tests into twill using the Ex AP-01 pistol and lab stock (Car-Bon 380 Auto Br/Br 70gr Cu-JHP Pow'R Ball) ammo at distances of contact, 3", 6", 12", 18", 24", 30", + 36"
- Performed a confirmatory test into twill using the Ex AP-01 pistol w/ one of the Ex AP-01 submitted cartridges (Car-Bon 380 Auto Br/Br 70gr Cu-JHP Pow'R Ball) at 30". Noticed significant differences in the GSR patterns (V/M)
- Performed a confirmatory test into twill using the Ex AP-01 pistol w/ lab stock (Car-Bon) ammo at 30". Similar pattern to original tests w/ lab ammo.
- Pulled one of the Ex AP-04 cartridges and noticed significant differences in gunpowder size and morphology (see photos). Spoke w/ Scott Hart at Car-Bon (800-626-7266) and he confirmed that they had started using different powder in April 2014. He stated that they changed powder every few years.
- Pulled a Glaser Safety Slug 380 Auto Br/Br (Win CC) 70gr Cu-JHP cartridge to compare gunpowder. Gunpowder was mostly disc shaped of similar size to Ex AP-04 powder.
- Performed tests into twill using the Ex AP-01 pistol and Glaser ammo at distances of 30", 36", and 40". Used to better estimate what distances to fire the submitted (AP-04) cartridges (limited supply). Not used to compare to Ex JSG-3.
- Performed tests into twill using the Ex AP-01 pistol and remaining Ex AP-04 cartridges at distances of 36" and 40".
- Performed a test into a sample of the Ex JSG-3 shirt (removed from back side) using the Ex AP-01 pistol and the Ex AP-02 cartridge (represented as having been removed from the ^{Chamber} Ex AP-03 ^{10/2/14} magazine). This test was a confirmatory test as well as observing any variables caused by the material of the shirt.

- NAR was not performed on any of the tests due to the lack of any useful information. No vaporous lead was found on the Ex 556-3 shirt and unwilling to give a lower bracket due to represent knowledge of two intervening objects (hands). Unable to determine distance based on lack of residues. This test is destructive and can be performed at a later time if necessary.

Results:

Examination of the Ex 556-3 shirt revealed a hole in the upper front area. The area around this hole was visually and microscopically examined and chemically processed for the presence of close range firearm discharge residues. Residues in the form of partially burned and unburned gunpowder and bullet wipe were found. Using the Ex AP-01 pistol, ^{the Ex AP-03 mag 10/11/14} laboratory ammunition, and the Ex AP-04 and AP-01 submitted ammunition, comparable residue patterns may be found ^{at 10/11/14} up to a distance of ^{less than 10/11/14} approximately 36" muzzle-to-object at the moment of discharge, having any intervening objects.

The Exhibit #16-ASK cartridge case was fired in the Exhibit #AP-01 pistol.

The Exhibit #AP-01 pistol was found to function properly when test fired with laboratory stock ammunition and the Exhibit #AP-03 magazine. The double action trigger pull measured approximately six and one-half (6 ½) to six and three-quarter (6 ¾) pounds. Cartridge cases fired in the pistol lack suitable imaging characteristics for the NIBIN database.

The Exhibit #AP-04 cartridges are suitable for use with the Exhibit #AP-01 pistol and the Exhibit #AP-03 magazine.

The Exhibit #SM-17A jacket was fired from the Exhibit #AP-01 pistol.

The Exhibit #SM-17B jacket fragment could neither be identified nor eliminated to the Exhibit #AP-01 pistol or the Exhibit #SM-17A jacket based on agreement of discernible class characteristics but insufficient agreement or disagreement of individual characteristics.

The Exhibit #SM-17C fragment is of no identification value to a specific firearm or bullet.
