DEMAND FOR NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CLAIM ALIBI

TO: Dino M. Michaels, Esq. and Richard Escobar, Esq.

As particularly as is known to the prosecuting attorney, the place, date and time of the commission of the crime charged in this case are as follows:

Between the hours of 12:01 A.M. and 11:59 P.M., on 01/13/14, in the vicinity of 6333 Wesley Grove Blvd, Wesley Chapel, Florida

This Demand for Notice of Intention to Claim Alibi may be considered as a Statement of Particulars in the event a Motion for Statement of Particulars is filed.

Under Rule 3.200, Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, if you intend to offer evidence of an alibi in your defense, you are hereby required to serve upon the office of the State Attorney of and for the Sixth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, not less than ten (10) days before trial, or such other time as the Court may direct, a notice in writing of your intention to claim an alibi. The notice shall contain specific information as to the place at which you claim to have been at the time of the alleged offense, and as particularly as is known to you or to your attorney, the names and addresses of the witnesses by whom you propose to establish such alibi. You are under a continuing duty to disclose promptly to the State Attorney's Office the names and addresses of any additional such witnesses which may come to your attention subsequent to the filing of your witness list.

If you fail in any particular to comply with the provisions of said Rule 3.200, a Motion will be made to exclude any and all evidence except your own testimony, offered by you for the purpose of proving an alibi.
