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**DEMAND FOR DISCOVERY**

The Defendant, by and through the undersigned attorney and pursuant to Rules of Criminal Procedure, Rule 3.220, hereby demands the State of Florida to disclose to the Defendant and undersigned counsel, and permit Defendant and undersigned counsel to inspect, copy, test, and photograph, the following information and material within the possession or control of the State:

1. The names and addresses of all persons known to the State to have information which may be relevant to the offense charged, and to any defense with respect thereto.
2. That statement of any person whose name was furnished in compliance with the preceding paragraph.
3. Any written or recorded statements and the substance of any oral statements made by Defendant, including any copies of statements made by Defendant, including any copies of statements contained in police reports or report summaries, together with the name and address of each witness to these statements.
4. Any written or recorded statements and the substance of any oral statements made by co-defendants if the trial is to be a joint one.

5. Those portions of recorded grand jury minutes that contain testimony of Defendant.
6. Any tangible papers or objects which were obtained from or belong to Defendant.
7. Whether the State has any material or information which has been provided by a confidential informant.
8. Whether there has been any electronic surveillance, including wire-tapping, of the premises of Defendant or conversations to which Defendant was a party and any documents relating thereto.
9. Where there has been any search or seizure and any documents relating thereto.
10. Reports or statements of experts made in connection with a particular case including results of physical or mental examinations and of scientific tests, experiments or comparisons.
11. Any tangible papers or objects which the State intends to use in the hearing or trial and which were not obtained from or belong to Defendant.
12. Any material information within the possession or control of the State which tends to negate the guilt of Defendant as to the offense charges.

Please indicate a time and place convenient to the State in which the foregoing materials may be inspected, copied, tested, and photographed.
